

Georgios D. Koyas graduated from the Department of Physics, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, (1969), received the MSc in “Electronics and Radioelectrology” (1974), the MSc in “Control and Computing” (1975) and the PhD in Digital Signal Processing and Filter Design (1985), all from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Greece. He has worked as a Research and Teaching Assistant in the University of Athens (1973-1982) and in parallel he has taught course in electronics in greek Higher Technological Education. Since 1983 he has been a professor in the Department of Electronics Engineering of the Technological Education Institute of Piraeus, where he has taught Electronics, Microcomputers and Digital Signal Processing courses and has served as the Head of the Department. He is a Professor Emeritus of the same Department since his retirement in 2011. Prof. Koyas is the author of journal papers in Digital Signal Processing algorithms and their fast implementations and of a series of textbooks for students (in greek).
